Where we are in Colorado Springs, CO

Current Status

Phase 1

Safe at Home; only essential businesses open; all Coloradans to stay at home

Phase 2









Safer at Home and in the Vast, Great Outdoors; some non-essential business to reopen; residents encouraged to stay at home

Phase 3

Protect Our Neighbors; community activities with 50% capacity permitted; no more than 500 people in one setting at a time

Phase 4

Pending government guidelines

Category		Status	Notes
	Open	✓	Reduced schedules for all airlines. Some concessions closed. Long Term parking and valet are closed and no curbside service available. Face covering required
	Rideshare	✓	Lyft and Uber are available
	Black Car	✓	Local car service providers limited on drivers but available with advanced reservations.
	Large Ground Transportation	✓	Available - working on industry guidelines to keep guests and drivers safe.
	Hotels & Resorts	✓	Hotels were not ordered to close but closed at their own discretion. Hotels and resorts are permitted to reopen at their own discretion
	Groups Welcome	✓	Groups cannot exceed 100 people per room depending on the useable square footage
	Restaurants	✓	Inside dining available with 50 % capacity or 50 people. Tables must be 6 ft. apart and no more than 10 patrons per table
	Bars	✓	Inside dining available with 50 % capacity or 50 people. Tables must be 6 ft. apart and no more than 10 patrons per table
	Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Depending on venue size, outdoor events can have a maximum of 175guests. Indoor venues cannot exceed 100guests per room depending on the useable square footage
	Live Music	✓	Live entertainment, artists are permitted at a distance of 25ft minimum.
	Tours Operating	✓	Small individual groups for some activities such as fly fishing with social distancing. Click here for a full list of attractions that are currently open
	State & Local Parks	✓	Camping allowed with reservations within counties that will allow it. Social distancing with groups suggested
	State Venue	✓	Some outdoor adventures are open with restrictions – click here for a full list

Current Status

Phase 1

Safe at Home; only essential businesses open, all Coloradans to stay at home

Phase 2









Safer at Home; some non-essential business to reopen; residents encouraged to stay at home; face mask mandatory for indoor facilities or while waiting in line to enter, and on public transportation

Phase 3

Protect Our Neighbors; community activities with 50% capacity permitted; no more than 500 people in one setting at a time

Phase 4

Pending government guidelines

Category		Status	Notes
	Open	✓	Reduced schedules for all airlines. Must wear masks throughout airport and flight. Shuttle Lots are closed. Some concessions and restaurants are open. DIA is following Denver's guidelines.
	Rideshare	✓	All local rideshare are available.
	Black Car	✓	Local car service providers limited on drivers but available with advanced reservations.
	Large Ground Transportation	✓	Reduced operating schedule
	Hotels & Resorts	✓	Hotels were not ordered to close but closed at their own discretion. Hotels and resorts are permitted to reopen at their own discretion.
	Groups Welcome	✓	Indoor events (conferences & receptions) can begin to reopen with no more than 75 guests. Double-sized rooms allowed to have up to 100 guests.
	Restaurants	✓	Inside dining available with 50 % capacity or 50 people. Tables must be 6 ft. apart and no more than 8 patrons per table
	Bars	✓	Bars who don't serve food need to remain closed. Bars who do serve food: Inside dining available with 50 % capacity or 50 people. Tables must be 6 ft. apart and no more than 8 patrons per table
	Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Depending on venue size, outdoor events can have a maximum of 175guests. Indoor venues cannot exceed 100guests per room depending on the useable square footage .
	Live Music	✓	Live entertainment, artists are permitted at a distance of 25ft minimum.
	Tours Operating	✓	Small individual groups for some activities such as fly fishing with social distancing.
	State & Local Parks	✓	Camping is allowed with reservations within counties that will allow it. Social distancing with groups suggested. Outdoor recreation permitted with limitations.
	State Venue	✗	All state venues are currently closed.

Note: Face masks or coverings are currently mandatory.

Note 2: Colorado does not currently have any travel restrictions.
