Category	Status	Notes
 Open	✓	All Airlines are on Limited Services to/from McCarran Airport – Currently, NO International Flights
 Rideshare	✓	
 Black Car	✓	Operating with safety limitations and protocols
 Large Ground Transportation	✓	Reduced operating schedule
 Hotels & Resorts	✓	Hotels and Resorts on the famous Strip are taking reservations and permitted to reopen
 Groups Welcome	✗	
 Restaurants	✓	Restaurants are allowed to reopen at 50% capacity implementing 6ft social distancing between tables. Bar areas in restaurants allowed to open under same restrictions.
 Bars	✓	Bars permitted to reopen at 50% capacity. Drinks only permitted to be served tableside in bars and restaurants.
 Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Casinos permitted to reopen under current guidelines. Limited capacities and social distancing implemented. All indoor and outdoor venues and attractions permitted to reopen at 50% capacity with social distancing measures implemented. Live performances are currently prohibited.
 Tours Operating	✓	ATV, UTV, Hummer, and hiking activities are operating for small groups.
 State & Local Parks	✓	Many parks are open to daytime use only. National Parks remain temporarily closed. Hoover Dam is Temporarily Closed to All Visitors.
