No gatherings over 10.
Limited businesses permitted to open at 25% capacity.

Phase 2













No gatherings over 10.
Limited businesses permitted to open at 50% capacity.

Phase 3

No gatherings over 10.
Businesses permitted to open at 50% capacity.
NOTE: Face coverings required.

Category	Status	Notes
 Open	✓	Dallas Fort Worth International Airport, Dallas Love Field Airport, Austin Bergstrom International Airport and San Antonio International Airport are all operational. Please note; airlines have adjusted schedules. For flight updates or cancellations, travelers should contact their carrier directly.
 Rideshare	✓	
 Black Car	✓	
 Large Ground Transportation	✓	
 Hotels & Resorts	✓	Hotels and Resorts are permitted to reopen at own discretion.
 Groups Welcome	✓	Groups are permitted but left at discretion of the hotels and resorts.
 Restaurants	✓	Restaurants are permitted to open at 75% capacity for dining inside the restaurant. No limit on outdoor dining, but no groups larger than 10.
 Bars	✗	Bars have been ordered to close as per June 26 th , 2020. Only To-Go orders.
 Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Entertainment venues are permitted to reopen at 50% capacity Outdoor events with attendance of 10 or more , needs to get approval prior to taking place.
 Tours Operating	✓	Tours and Activities are permitted to reopen at 50% capacity.
 State & Local Parks	✓	Parks may operate up to 50% of the total listed occupancy.
 State Venue	✓	Museums and libraries may operate up to 75% of the total listed occupancy but must close any components of the museum or library that have interactive functions or exhibits, including child play areas.
NOTE 1:	Face coverings or masks are mandatory in the State of Texas.	
NOTE 2:	There are no restrictions visiting Texas, however upon return you will be required to self-quarantine if you reside in one of the following States: AK, HI, CT, ID, IL, KS, KY, ME, MA, NH, NJ, NM, NY, PA, RI, VT, DC. Please check your local guidelines for duration of quarantine.
