Where we are in Las Vegas, NV

Phase 1

No gatherings over 10
Restaurants at 50% capacity
Hotels, bars, casinos and venues closed

Phase 2

No gatherings larger than 50
Venues, Casinos and hotels permitted to open in limited capacity

Phase 3







Category	Status	Notes
 Open	✓	All Airlines are on Limited Services to/from McCarran Airport – Currently, NO International Flights
 Rideshare	✓	
 Black Car	✓	Operating with safety limitations and protocols
 Large Ground Transportation	✓	Reduced operating schedule
 Hotels & Resorts	✓	Taking reservations and permitted to reopen.
 Groups Welcome	✓	Exempt from 25% rule.
 Restaurants	✓	Restaurants are allowed to reopen at 25% capacity implementing 6ft social distancing between tables. 4 guests per table max.
 Bars	✓	Bars permitted to reopen at 25% capacity. Drinks only permitted to be serviced tableside in bars and restaurants.
 Casinos	✓	Casinos permitted to reopen under current guidelines.
 Entertainment & Event venues	✓	All indoor and outdoor venues and attractions permitted to reopen at 25% capacity or 50 guests maximum. Events up to 50 guests will require approved permit with social distancing measures implemented. Live performances permitted at 25ft distance.
 Tours Operating	✓	ATV, UTV, Hummer, and hiking activities are operating for small groups.
State & Local Parks	✓	Many parks are open to daytime use only. National Parks limited opening. Hoover Dam is open with limitations.
