## The Reopening Roadmap

Where we are in Nashville, TN

### Phase 1

No gatherings over 10  
Restaurants and Bars servicing food open at 50%  
Venues closed, no live music permitted

### Phase 2

Small Gatherings up to 50  
Restaurants and Bars servicing food open at 50%  
Social events at 125 guests max













### Phase 3

Gathering size 500 max. Open to Events  
Restaurants, Bars, Tours and Venues at 50% capacity. Retail at 75%

### Phase 4

Gathering size TBD  
Restaurants, Bars, Attractions, and Venues open at full capacity  
Sport venues open

 Open	✓	Limited frequency and capacity: Current operating airlines: Alaska Air, Allegiant, American Airlines, Delta Airlines, Frontier, JetBlue, Southwest, United Airlines. See <a href="#">here</a> for airport sanitation guidelines at BNA
 Rideshare	✓	
 Black Car	✓	Prior reservation recommended.
 Large Ground Transportation	✓	Reduced operating schedule.
 Hotels & Resorts	✓	The convention hotels in Nashville are permitted to reopen at their own discretion. Social distancing measures need to be in place.
 Groups Welcome	✓	Up to hotel discretion. Guidelines recommend limitation to 50% capacity in common areas.
 Restaurants	✓	Restaurants and Bars <u>servicing food</u> are currently allowed to open their dining rooms at 100 guests per floor/100 outside. No parties larger than 8 guests. Seated only. Mandatory close at 11:00PM
 Bars	✓	Bars permitted to reopen for seated service only. Maximum of 100 guests per floor/100 outside.
 Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Permitted to reopen at 50% capacity or 500 guests maximum. Any group over 25 requires a permit, Metro approval.
 Live Music	✓	Live entertainment permitted. No more than 2 performers. Dancefloors closed. 15ft from guests.
 Tours Operating	✓	Tours, activities and attractions are permitted to reopen at 50% capacity. Tour groups 25 guests max.
 State & Local Parks	✓	Many hiking trails, and parks are open. Here is a <a href="#">complete list</a> of regional parks open.
 State Venue	✓	Museums and Attractions open at 50% capacity. NFL and MLS allowed 10% attendance.

## The Reopening Roadmap

Where we are in Chattanooga, TN

### Phase 1

Restaurants and Retailers permitted to open at 50% capacity.

Hotels permitted to receive guests.

### Phase 2

Gatherings up to 50 people permitted.














All businesses permitted to open following CDC Health Guidelines.

### Phase 3

No percentage or number on size limit of gatherings, however strict CDC health guidelines and distancing is required.

Category	Status	Notes
 Open	✓	All airlines are operating in limited frequency and capacity.
 Rideshare	✓	
 Black Car	✓	Prior reservation recommended.
 Large Ground Transportation	✓	Reduced operating schedule.
 Hotels & Resorts	✓	Convention hotels are allowed to reopen, but with limited service options.
 Groups Welcome	✓	Up to hotel discretion. No limitation on group size. Social distancing required.
 Restaurants	✓	Restaurants are currently allowed to open without capacity limit with 6ft. spacing between tables.
 Bars	✓	Bars are currently allowed to open without capacity limit with 6ft. distancing in place. <b>Seated only</b>
 Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Attractions and Larger venues are permitted to open at their discretion. CDC and State Guidelines are required to be followed. No capacity limit as long as social distancing is practiced.
 Live Music	✓	Permitted, but with 15ft distance between performers and audience.
 Tours Operating	✓	All attractions and tour are permitted to open without capacity limitations. Social distancing required.
 State & Local Parks	✓	Many hiking trails, and parks are open. Here is a <a href="#">complete list</a> of regional parks open. Social distancing and facemask recommended and, in some cases, required.
 State Venue	✓	Museums and venues are permitted to open at their discretion. CDC and State Guidelines are required to be followed.
Additional State Resources		
<b>NOTE 1:</b>	Face coverings or masks are highly recommended in Chattanooga, TN but are not mandatory. However, business may require wearing a facemask before entering.
