	Hotels & Resorts	✓	Open with modifications. Though San Francisco's travel quarantine for travelers from outside the Bay Area has lifted, the State's travel advisory requiring that non-essential travelers from our of state or beyond 120 miles quarantine for 10 days remains.
	Groups Welcome	✓	<b>Effective April 15 –</b> Outdoor – Max of 100 people. If all guests are tested or show proof of full vaccine – Max 300. Indoor – If all tested and proof of vaccine – Max 150
	Restaurants	✓	Indoor dining may open up to the lesser of 50% maximum occupancy or 200 people. San Francisco will limit indoor dining tables to members of 1 household up to max 4 people and end by 10:00 pm
	Bars, Wineries, Breweries & Distilleries	✓	Wineries, Breweries, Distilleries - Indoor open with modifications, Capacity limited to 25% or 100 people. Bars – outdoor only with modifications
	Entertainment & Event venues	✓	Outdoor only with modifications. Golf open but limited. Amusement parks – smaller parks open with modifications, 25% capacity or 500 pp, outdoor attractions only, in-county visitors only.
	Tours Operating	✓	Some tours are operating at reduced capacity. Alcatraz is open for outdoor viewing only. Interiors of buildings remain closed.
	State & Local Parks	✓	Most county parks and trails reopened. <a href="#">List of parks open and closed.</a>
	State Venue	✓	Museums, zoos & aquariums can open indoor with modifications limited to 50% capacity.
